friends, and the community will gather to honor his memory and celebrate all that he gave to those around him.

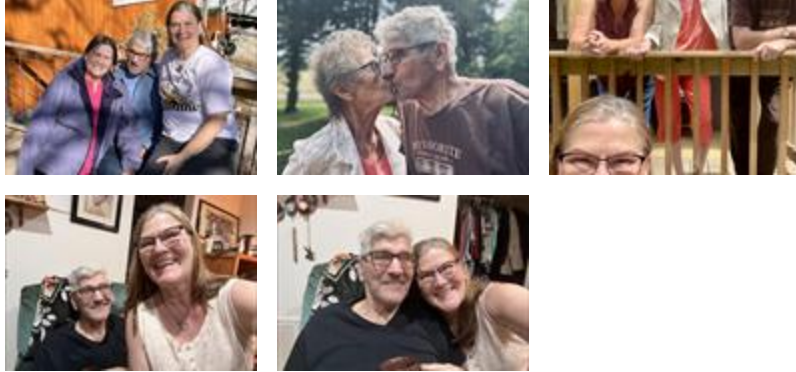
Max Sewick will be dearly missed, but his spirit remains in the hearts of those who loved him.

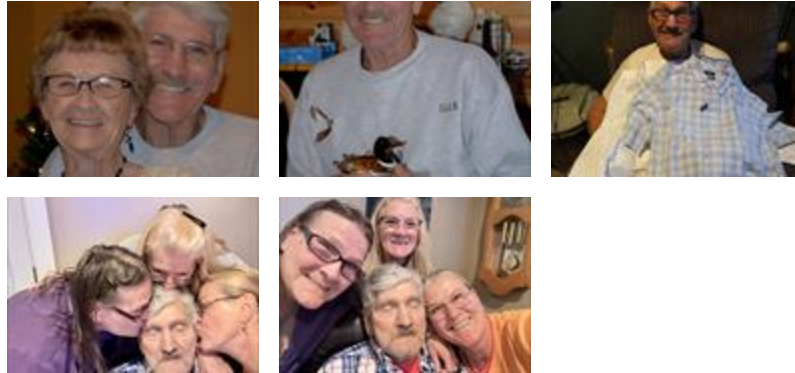

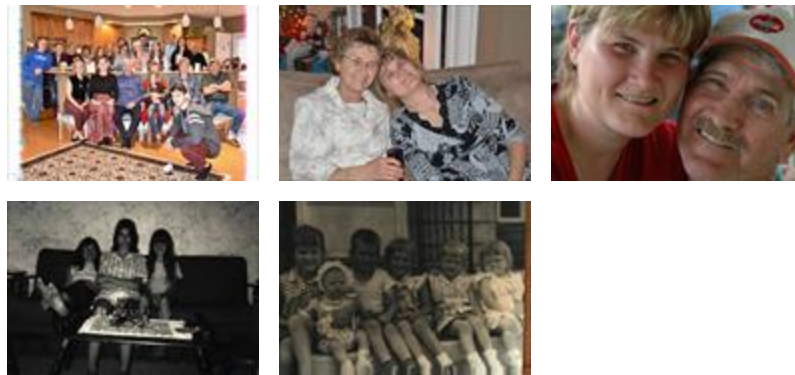
